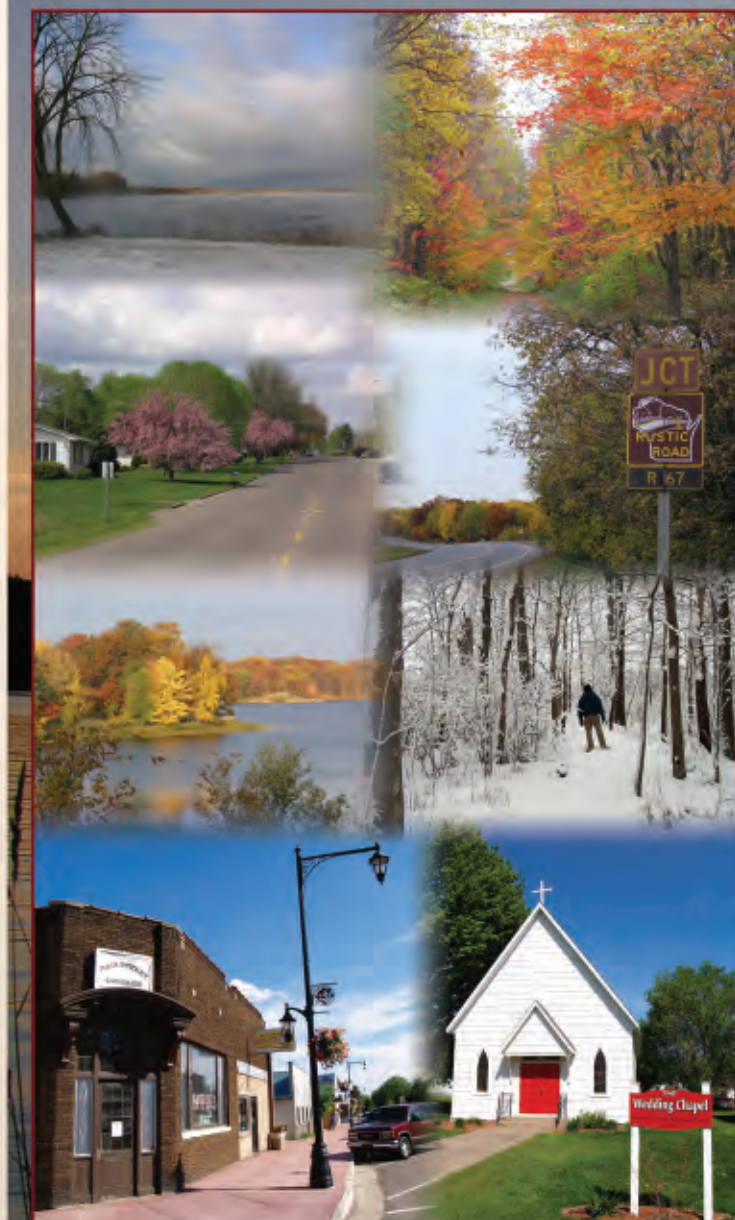

OUR HISTORY

Our area has been home to local Chippewa (Ojibwa) people for thousands of years. They traded with French and English fur traders for 200 years before European settlers began arriving in the 1800's. Joel Richardson, one of the early settlers, named the town Skowhagen after his hometown in Maine. However, government survey crews who noticed many turtles laying eggs on the banks named the lakes in 1862. When the Chicago and North Western railroad was built past the lakes, the lumber company requested supplies to be delivered to Turtle Lake and not the town of Skowhagen; eventually, the Post Office was established and designated as Turtle Lake. We also hold a significant railway history as we are situated as the crossroads of the Omaha and Soo Line Rail. Although, rail no longer exists, the Omaha is a 'snowmobile trail and the Soo, now Cattail Trail, is a multi-use trail.

TL IN A NUTSHELL

Turtle Lake is home to 1,164 residents and a wide variety of industries, including commercial, manufacturing and agriculture. Three of the top ten largest employers in Barron County exist in TL. You will also find the various services and business expected in a modern community.



CASINO & HOTEL

The St. Croix Casino & Hotel offers high-stakes gaming 24 hours a day in an elegant Northwoods atmosphere. The 158 room hotel offers complementary continental breakfast. The Casino has three restaurants and offers banquet and convention service, valet parking and live entertainment on weekends.



RECREATION

The Village has many opportunities for outdoor activities. The Cattail Trail is open year round and stretches 21 miles from Amery to Almena. Railway Park is just off the trail in the downtown business district. The Village Park, located on US Hwy. 8 & 63, offers camping with water and electric hook-ups, basketball court, baseball field, outdoor ice rink, picnic shelters and a playground area. We are also surrounded by a chain of lakes, including Upper and Lower Turtle Lake, Horseshoe, Echo, Moon, Skinaway, Loon, Staples, and other smaller lakes. We offer excellent fishing, golfing, vacation sports, resorts, and year-round or seasonal homes. In the fall the area erupts into a blaze of autumn splendor of hardwood forests that surround clear-water lakes and streams. For the winter enthusiast, there is ice fishing, snowmobiling, and cross-country skiing on area trails.
